## Youth Rugby Team Safeguarding Policy Last Updated: July 2025

#### 1. Purpose

Elite Youth Rugby is committed to creating a safe, inclusive, and positive environment for all young players. This policy outlines our approach to safeguarding children and young people from harm, abuse, or neglect.

#### 2. Our Commitment

- O Prioritize the welfare of all players.
- O Ensure all coaches, volunteers, and staff are vetted (e.g., background checks) and trained in safeguarding.
- 0 Promote a culture where concerns are reported and addressed promptly.

#### 3. Roles & Responsibilities

- Obesignated Safeguarding Officer (our CSO): Peter Hayes is the primary contact for safeguarding concerns. Contact: <u>CSO@EliteYouthRugby.com</u>
- **Ocaches/Volunteers:** Must follow youth safeguarding guidelines and report concerns,
- **Operate Support** Parents/Guardians: Support the policy and report any concerns.

#### 4. Safe Recruitment

All adults working with youth players must:

- O Complete a background check (e.g., criminal records screening).
- O Provide references.
- Attend safeguarding training.

#### 5. Code of Conduct Summarised - see also our full Codes of Conduct

For Staff/Volunteers:

- 0 Never be alone with a child; use the "two-adult rule" where possible.
- O Avoid physical contact unless necessary (e.g., first aid or coaching corrections).
- O Do not contact players privately via personal social media/phone.

## For Players:

- 1 Treat teammates, opponents, and officials with respect.
- 0 Report any concerns to a coach or the CSO.

#### For Parents:

- Encourage fair play and respect.
- Report concerns to the DSO (not directly confront other parents/players).

## **Reporting Concerns**

- 0 If a child is in immediate danger, call emergency services.
- 0 For non-urgent concerns (e.g., bullying, suspected abuse), contact the DSO.
- O All reports will be handled confidentially and escalated to local child protection authorities if needed.

## 7. Photography & Social Media

- O Parental consent is required for taking/sharing photos/videos of players.
- O Avoid identifying children by full name or location online.

#### 8. Anti-Bullying Policy

Bullying (verbal, physical, or online) will not be tolerated. Incidents will be investigated and addressed promptly.

## 9. Review & Training

- 0 This policy is reviewed annually.
- O Staff/volunteers must complete safeguarding training every [1–2 years].
